1. Gabriel Dolf Lupient

Arrived with Louis Rivers and family on April 1, 1872 to fall the first tree and help build Marshfield's first building, a log hotel. Played by Ken Bargander

2. Anna Lathrop

Witnessed the Great Marshfield Fire and first woman elected to the Marshfield City Council Played by Tami Jackan

3. Sgt. Willard Purdy

Marshfield's best known World War I hero Played by Greg Jackan

4. Gov. William H. Upham

Early Marshfield industrialist and prominent businessman, Mayor during the Great Marshfield Fire, and the only Marshfield resident to serve as Wisconsin's governor. Played by Tom Drendel

5. Mary Upham

Early Marshfield civic leader, mentor of the Marshfield youth, and leader of the relief effort after the Great Marshfield Fire Played by Shirley Mook

6. Mrs. Barbara Haebig

Maker of the American Flag for the first Fourth of July Parade held in Marshfield in 1879.

Played by Vickie Schnitzler

7. Otto Scharmann

Upham Manufacturing employee at time of Marshfield Fire. Helped to battle the flames at the Upham Plant and downtown Marshfield on June 27, 1887.

8. Clara Erion Thomas


Witnessed the Great Marshfield Fire of 1887 Played by Jean Swenson
